APPLICATION – IT'S THAT EASY

1 OPEN THE TUBE



**! Use immediately
upon receipt!**

Carefully open the tube immediately before application and use the contents directly after receipt.

2 DISTRIBUTE THE EGGS



Distribute the contents evenly over affected plants – preferably on leaf undersides, close to pest colonies.

3 LARVAE HATCH



At 15–20 °C, the larvae hatch after approximately 2–7 days and immediately begin hunting pests.

4 ENJOY THE RESULTS



Within a short time, you will see fewer pests and healthier, stronger plants.

! IMPORTANT INFORMATION



Do not apply in direct sunlight. Apply in the morning or evening.



Development slows below 15 °C. The optimal range is 15–25 °C.



Plants should be slightly moist, but not wet.



Ants can eat the eggs and young larvae. If ants are abundant, control them first or place the eggs where ants cannot easily reach them.



TIPS FOR BEST RESULTS

- ✓ Apply at the first signs of infestation.
- ✓ Distribute evenly over several plants.
- ✓ Treat leaf undersides and young shoots especially thoroughly.
- ✓ For severe infestations, apply again after 2–3 weeks.
- ✓ Ideal in combination with other beneficial organisms for a permanently healthy garden.

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1. WHAT ARE LACEWING EGGS?

Lacewing eggs come from the green lacewing (*Chrysoperla carnea*), a beneficial insect. The tiny, pale eggs are laid on fine stalks and mark the beginning of especially voracious lacewing larvae – natural enemies of many plant pests.



2. WHICH PESTS DO THE LARVAE TARGET?

3. HOW MANY EGGS DOES ONE TUBE CONTAIN?

One tube contains **over 400 lacewing eggs** and covers an area of **up to 10 m²**.



4. WHEN IS THE BEST TIME TO APPLY THEM?

Application is possible from **spring to late summer** as soon as the first pests appear on the plants. Ideal temperatures are between **15–25 °C**.



5. HOW DO I APPLY THE LACEWING EGGS?

Open the tube immediately upon receipt and carefully distribute the contents over affected plants – preferably on leaf undersides and close to pest colonies.



6. HOW LONG UNTIL THEY TAKE EFFECT?

Depending on the temperature, the eggs hatch after approximately **2–7 days**. The larvae then immediately begin hunting pests. The best results are usually visible within **1–3 weeks**.



7. CAN I USE THE EGGS IN A GREENHOUSE OR ON A BALCONY?

Yes. Lacewing eggs are ideal for gardens, greenhouses, raised beds, balconies and even indoor spaces – wherever pests occur.



8. ARE LACEWING EGGS SAFE FOR PEOPLE, ANIMALS AND THE ENVIRONMENT?

Yes, lacewing eggs are completely safe. They contain no chemicals and are safe for people, pets, bees and other beneficial organisms.



9. WHAT SHOULD I KNOW ABOUT ANTS?

Ants can eat lacewing eggs and newly hatched larvae because they regard them as food. If ants are abundant, control them first or place the eggs where ants cannot easily reach them, such as on elevated plant parts or hanging plants.



10. CAN I USE MORE THAN ONE TUBE?

Yes. For a larger infestation or area, you can apply several tubes at the same time. Distribute the eggs evenly over all affected plants.



11. WHAT HAPPENS AFTER THE PESTS ARE CONTROLLED?

After successful pest control, the larvae die off naturally or move on. They leave no residue and help restore the ecological balance in your garden.
